

COVID 19 Protocols at Emmanuel

Sunday Mornings

Attendance is taken for contact tracing purposes

Hand sanitizer is available

Masks are mandatory while you are in the building

Please stay 6' apart when possible even while wearing a mask

When entering the building please go directly to the auditorium to be seated.

Seating in the auditorium is roped off and ushers are seating people

Singing occurs at the end of the service so those that are not comfortable with singing can leave

We are dismissing people (starting from the back row). We ask that you please leave the building immediately after the service.

We are limited to 30% capacity in each room

An Offering table is set up at back of the church, so no plates are passed during the service.

Individually prewrapped communion kits are available to pick up from a table as you enter the auditorium (on Communion Sundays)

Our target is to have services 1 hour in length.

Children

Summit is taking place for JK-Gr. 6

Parents are encouraged to pre-register their children if possible (JK to Grade 6) for updates and links visit our Children's Facebook page, EBC Kids.

How this works is children go right down to fellowship hall, doors open at 9:50 am; they distance and wear masks. Children are dismissed one family at a time and returned to their family in the auditorium for worship at the end of the service.

In addition to this family tables have been set up in the cafe for those with young children. Activity bags are available in the lobby. The nursery and conference room are designated as "wobble room" if parents wish to use those
