1. When do we first see Saul in Acts? What was activities was he involved in?
2. Think about the time before you met Jesus and accepted him as your Saviour. What factors led you to make the decision to be a lifelong follower of Christ?
3. How did Paul characterize his own life before his experience on the road to Damascus?
See Philippians 3:3-6
4. In light of that, what things did you need to "give up" to follow Jesus?
5. We are constantly tempted to give in to temptation of sin, how does the thought "But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ," (Phil 3:7-8), encourage you to remain faithful to the Lord
6. Read Ephesians 2:1-10, describe God's activity before we repented and followed him
7. Do you know someone who you think is just about impossible to reach with the gospel?
In light of Paul's experience, how can you and I pray for that person?
8. Are people really dead in their sin? What does that mean and what role does God have and what role to believers have in awakening people?
9. Develop a list of 3-5 people for whom you are praying for God to awaken spiritually.
Share their names with your group.
10. There was a marked change in Paul's life after he met Jesus, share how Jesus is changing you.
