7. Tabitha illustrates how believers ought to demonstrate the reality of their faith through their good works. Read James 2:14-17 and comment on importance of good works in our lives.
8. What attitudes should believers have when God does special things in our lives? Share with your group when God did something special for you.
9. How does the statement “God is writing his story through you” help you each day that you live?
10. What is God’s goal in all of lives experiences? How can that perspective encourage you to keep going?
