Digging Deeper

1. **Read Acts 16:6-10.** Where are "Phrygia," "Galatia" (Acts 16:6), "Mysia," and "Bithynia" (Acts 16:7)? Where is Macedonia? Follow this path on a map and see how unusual a route this is.
2. Who stopped the Paul and his companions? What were they stopped from doing? Why did he forbid them from doing this?
3. Who joins the missionary team in Troas? (Hint: we)
4. **Read Acts 19:8-10.** What was accomplished by the end of Acts 19:10?
5. How can a Christian know if he is walking in true dependence on the Holy Spirit?
6. How can we know the Spirit's leading on issues where the Bible does not give specific help?
7. How can we know exactly where God wants us to be serving Him? What factors should we consider?
8. Do you think that God still guides through dreams or visions? If so, how can we know if it's from God?

As you go ...

1. What principles can help us know whether or not we are being guided by the Lord regarding a certain decision we have to make?
2. What things can I be doing today that will help me to understand the will of God in my life today, tomorrow, a year from now, etc.?
