5. What does Paul say was at the heart of his life and ministry? (vv.13-15) What motivated him to stay on track? What is it at the heart of your life/ministry?
6. How does faith become ours and not the imposition of others?
7. What were the evidences of the work of the Spirit in Paul's life and ministry? What constrained Paul, what compelled him and what were the cautions? Acts 21:7-14
8. How did Paul imitate the path of Jesus in this section of Scripture? Vv.13-15
9. How do we in 2021 faithfully follow the Lord's will?
10. Have you ever received counsel from a godly friend that was different from what you believed God was telling you? How did you handle that?
11. How can we pray for one another as we discern the leading of God in our lives?
